


The British Barcelona Club

The 2014 AGM was opened at 2.30pm with 24 members and Committee attending. Apologies were given to those Committee members who were unable to attend. The minutes of the 2013 AGM were passed as any matters arising covered.

There was one question from the floor regarding outside organisations and where on the accounts it shows how much income received. The Secretary explained that any income from other organisations is shown on the income for each race under other organisations. The accounts were then accepted and passed. We received 89 resignations which were accepted with regret. As it was the end of 2014 business all offices were declared vacant and Tony Whitehurst kindly stood in as temporary Chairman. The result of the ballot: 132 papers returned, 4 unsigned and not counted. Proposition 1 Proposed by M & E Shepherd. (D468). Delete Club Rule 13 and Insert New Club Rule 13. To read: Publication in the fancy press of

race results, alterations to the rules or regulations, shall be deemed notice to all members. 91 for, 28 against, 9 abstentions. Proposition 2. Proposed by P J Wells. (D435). Delete Race Rule 9 and Insert New Race Rule 9. To read: Form A to be in the Secretary's hands 5 days before the date of marking of each race. Form B to be delivered with the birds at the marking station. Form A received after the given date, may be returned to the competitor with notification that his birds cannot be accepted. Extra birds will be accepted on the day of marking, but limited to no more than original entry (room permitting). No extra pools/noms to be added. Birds to be paid for at the markings. 24 for, 104 against, 0 abstentions. Finally, permission was given to destroy old documents and the AGM closed at 3pm.
