With hope that our next race in June will be from France, the Committee voted to change our first race from Ilkeston to Wadebridge in anticipation of the birds flying south. It was yet another weekend that had forecast heavy rain and showers for both Saturday and Sunday but our Race Advisor Roger Hurst had been scrutinising the weather and saw a perfect window on Saturday morning where if we liberated between 8am and 9am any rain showers after that would follow us up. The liberation of 1,590 birds sent by 132 members was 8.45am in to a moderate west – south westerly. I’ve been asked to thank Roger for a cracking decision to let them go when we did on such a difficult weather weekend and to thank Pat and Steve for looking after the birds so well, returns were excellent. Thank you to everyone involved at the marking stations for all your help, especially the ones that had to endure the constant heavy rain whilst trying to mark outside on Thursday.

Many congratulations to our race winners Steve Dickinson and Phil Newton of Weston Super Mare **1st Open 1st Section C** also **6th & 8th Open** as well. Firstly we would like to congratulate all other section winners. The bird we timed first was purchased from P & D racing and breeding stud in the Midlands. She is flown on the chaos system, as a young bird she was raced to Truro. This year in preparation for the B.B.C Wadebridge race she had two races with the W.O.E.S.R.C.

The partnership works well with Steve doing the majority of training, feeding and organisation of which birds go to which races and his father in law John Harris doing the majority of loft cleaning and general help, being a former pigeon fancier himself. Phil breeds around 50 young birds each year to add to the racing loft and transports the birds to the marking stations, he also mixes and prepares the feed for the birds which is purchased as straight grains from local farmers.

Steve is no stranger to training and preparing birds to optimum fitness as he is a former falconer, until Phil and John convinced him to keep the hunted not the hunter. Steve is a hard taskmaster and gives the birds plenty of training before and during the racing season, which should stand this loft in good stead for future years to come.

Convoyers Report

Thursday 13th May: Finished loading at Southampton at 4.15pm. Drove straight to Wadebridge, arrived at 8.45pm. Put water on birds straight away and left lights on inside transporter until 11pm.

Friday 14th May: Up at 7am. Topped up water and gave birds a half feed at 8.30am. Water kept topped up all day and at 3pm birds were given another half feed.

Phoned Roger Hurst (Race Advisor) at 5.30pm. He said to phone him at 6.30am to let him know what the weather was like on site.

Saturday 15 May: Up at 6am, a little cold and overcast. Phoned Roger at 6.30am and told him the weather at the site. He said to phone him back at 7.30am which I did, then broken blue skies and a bit warmer and visibility of around 10 miles. He said to phone back at 8.15am and to move the transporter into position. Phoned Roger at 8.15am and told him it was looking better. He said there was a window between 8.30am and 9am. I told him I thought we could be ready for an 8.45am lib.

Birds liberated at 8.45am into a moderate West South West. Birds headed East straightaway and were out of sight in under a minute in one batch except for 50-60 birds who broke away from the main batch but still left the area in under a minute.
