She is bred from a pair of pigeons I purchased from P & D Stud her sire being a son of favourite Pitbull and the dam is a daughter of Neiuew Goede Roede breeders of several first prize winners for me.

Second in was 5 year old Vandenabeele hen purchased from Mark Evans as a racing kit, she has been a really consistent pigeon winning many prizes over her long racing career and I suppose intelligent to be able to reach 5 years old these days!!


Third over the pad was a pigeon given to me by Paul & Darren at P & D Stud to race and has been a first prize winner at club level with some good National & Classic performances too.

Thursday 12 May

Finished loading at Southampton at 4pm. Got into Portsmouth docks at 4.30pm. Gave birds a light feed and water.

Friday 13 May

Got off ship at 3.30am and arrived on site at 4am. Up at 6.30am and filled drinkers and gave birds a light feed at 7am. Drinkers topped up all day and another light feed was given at 1pm. Phoned Roger (Race Advisor) at 2pm to talk about tomorrow's lib. He said all looking well for an early lib and to phone him at 7am in the morning.

Saturday 14 May

Up at 5.30am and topped up waters. Phoned Roger at 6.45am and told him the weather here was great with no wind and the BICC were going to lib at 7am. I said to Roger, if the BICC lib was good, could we go at 7.15am and he agreed.

Liberation was at 7.15am, no wind and over 20 miles visibility. Birds broke into 3 batches. 2 of the batches joined together after 2 minutes headed home. This was the vast majority of the birds. The last batch flew around for another 2 minutes and then headed home.

Once again a big thank you to local fanciers Nigel and Glen for everything they did for us and the BICC boys.

For South Road racing (Guernsey) CSCFC/ BBC/ BICC members will have to take their birds to a BICC marking station only.

Duplications from one club to another will be allowed at £1.50 per pigeon.
