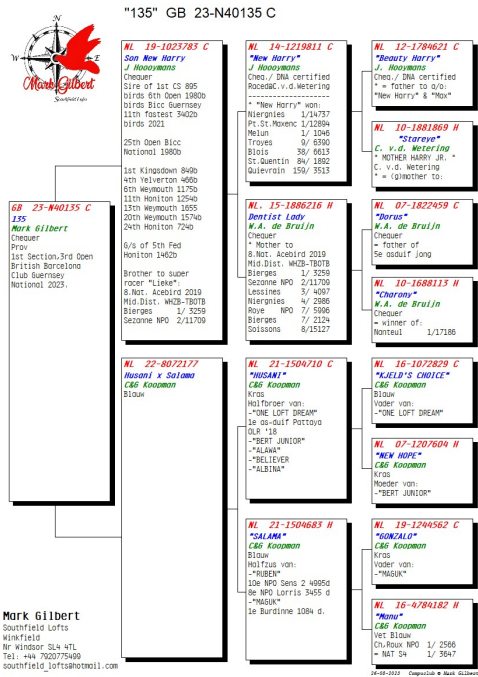

The sire is a full brother to his best hen Maggie a muti National winner who same lines bred 1<sup>st</sup> BBC YB Nat 2021 and also scored in both NRCC and BICC races. My 2<sup>nd</sup> pigeon which was 3 seconds behind is a blue pied hen bred from a Herman Beverdam Geerinckx x Gaston x Foxy Lady lines from Syndicate lofts which parents have bred good birds to score in BBC BICC and national races including a half brother to win 48 open Bordeaux this year.

I had a second bird, 21 minutes later, probably taking 2<sup>nd</sup> Section. Returns were good, having 7 out of 8 by nightfall. It was nice to see three drop together after 5 1/4 hours.

Well done Lance and Graham on winning and a big thank you to all the organisers that make this racing possible.



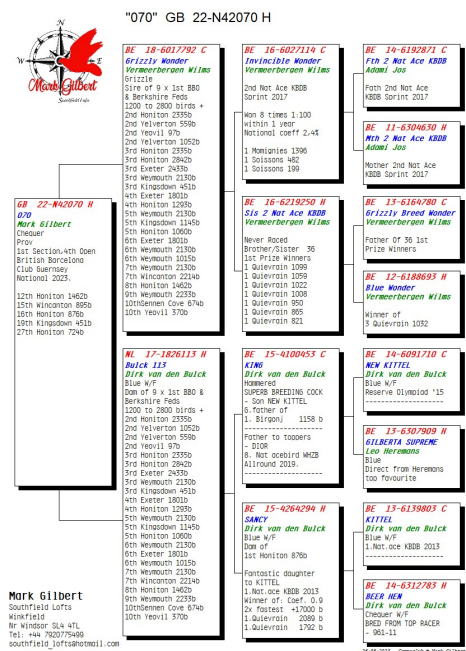

**1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Section C Mark & Clare Brown of Hungerford.** Firstly like to say well done to the winners, the convoyers for the condition of the birds and your racing committee & race advisors on getting a tricky race weather wise done & dusted.

We entered 5 old hens for this race and look likely to have the first five in the section due to the wind, we had two of our birds return together to record 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Section, prov 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> Open with velocities of 1573ypm.



First bird clocked was our yearling hen who returned from the first Classic race of the year just behind our first birds who won 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> open but she had been hawked and freshly wounded, she has been racing as trainers with the young birds and was actually our first recorded bird last week from Exeter when we had 7 on the drop where she beat the actual fed winning young bird loft mate by 3 seconds, she is from our Gert Heylen x Lambrecht family. Our 2<sup>nd</sup> bird is a 3 year old white flight hen bred by Les Nichols of Bristol, from his Gerrit Lahuis family, she again has been racing with the young birds and was with the first drop last week and also was first over the pads in the midweek Wincanton the week before to beat the club winning young bird by 2 seconds.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Section A Rob Jones & Jamie Wells (Bartlett, Jones & Wells) of Southampton.** This 5 year old blue hen has been very consistent for us. She was our favoured pigeon being pooled all the way through. She won the Section in the BBC Ilkeston Old Bird race last year.

**Next in Section B Mel & Sue King of Blandford Forum.** Congratulations to all the winners.

Our first bird was a yearling hen out of our well established Vandenbeelee based family. Bred from a son of our NFC Countances National Winner when paired to a daughter of our BICC Le Mans National Winners. The yearling hen missed most of the old bird race season after returning from NFC Fougères National missing most of her tail and some wing flights with nasty talon gashes to her underside from a Peregrine Falcon strike. Thanks to all the markers and officials.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Section C Geoff & Catherine Cooper of Peasedown St John.** At the end of July we started exercising 10 hens who haven't raced since young birds, they were a mix of ages. The widowhood cocks they were previously paired to didn't race this year as they were used as breeders due to us having our stock cocks stolen.

The hens were trained with the young birds and sent as trainers to the young bird races.

The race from Guernsey was their first race of the season. They came well as a team, clocking 9/10 in good time, including 4/10 within 90 seconds.

The hen we timed first was a yearling, bred from a son of Farmer George and Wollongong and the dam was a sister to Lady of the Night, who is a grandchild of Farmer George and Wollongong.
